Both The Australian Press Council guidelines and the official UNESCO definition of Auschwitz-Birkenau unequivocally indicate the need to avoid potentially offensive terminology and use a more accurate and appropriate description of "German Nazi Concentration Camps", adding their location as being "In Occupied-Poland".
